Nature of Support – 2017/2018

- Funding utilised to purchase the services of a PE Teacher, to provide high-quality PE provision across school.
- PE Teacher to support the professional development of other staff, in order to further develop subject knowledge, quality of teaching and learning in PE and assessment.
- PE Teacher to deliver a bespoke Coaching and Mentoring Plan to a staff member supporting the delivery of quality PE provision.
- Funding utilised to provide a range of sports-related After-School Clubs, to encourage pupils to become fit and active.
- PE Teacher to support 'Lunchtime Peer Supporters', in organising and facilitating further activities at Lunchtime.
- PE Teacher to facilitate participation in competitive sports, both within school and within the wider community.

Impact - 2017/2018

As a result of the effective utilisation of the funding -

- The quality of teaching and learning in PE is at least good. All pupils engage in regular physical activity.
- PE Teacher has worked alongside other staff to plan, deliver and assess PE, thus improving overall CPD and the quality of teaching and learning in PE, through bespoke Coaching and Mentoring Plans.
- A full range of After-School Clubs have been offered during the academic year and have been well-attended.
- Effective utilisation of the Lunchtime Peer Supporters and PE Teacher has led to more pupils

being active during Lunchtimes and taking part in structured activities, thus adding to an improvement in the quality of provision.

• Pupils have participated in inter-school competitions and have achieved various successes, including a team of pupils with SEND, who recently won The Black Country Games.
