Addendum to Behaviour Policy in response to the Covid 19 Pandemic.

Routines

- Parents/children to access school through the entrances they have been allocated, obtaining a 1m distance, utilising the markers on the floor.
- Member of staff to open gate, supervise the children entering the playground/building and reminding parents/children of social distancing.
- Break times will be staggered to ensure only two Year Groups are on the playground at one time and these two Year Groups are separated.
- At lunchtime, children will remain in class to eat their lunch and will be allocated a slot on the playground/field. Only two Year Groups will be out at a time. These Year Groups will not mix.
- Children will use the toilets that have been allocated to their class.
- All classrooms will have an internal radio, so contact with an SMT member can be made immediately, if needed.
- Children will have their own equipment in a bag to use, provided by school.

Behaviour

Our first priority remains to reward and create opportunities for rewarding. Staff will ensure they continue to look for the positives and praise individuals.

In terms of rewards, the staff will use the following:

- Praise
- Team points
- Work shared with class
- Class points
- Raffle tickets
- Certificates

Golden Time will take place in Year Group Bubbles in classrooms. No iPads, computers or outside to be utilised for Golden Time. Choose activities that can be easily managed in the classroom. Whole class games, DVD, colouring etc.

In terms of consequences, our Behaviour Consequence System has been updated as follows:

- Step 1: Quiet, discrete verbal warning
- Step 2: Yellow card 5 mins in classroom
- Step 3: Red card 10 mins in partner teacher's classroom
- Step 4: Referral to Phase Leader

Step 5: If the incident is serious and support is needed urgently, then use internal radio to ask for support from a member of the SMT team

Any child on an IBP will continue with their reward chart - rewards will be class-based.

Alongside the normal classroom standards, the following standards also need to be shared and discussed with all children.

- Children to wash hands regularly using the hand sanitizer/hand wash supplied.
- Children to remain in their YG bubble and not to interact with pupils from another YG bubble.
- Children to stay in their allocated areas both inside/outside the building, keeping 2m apart, as much as possible.
- Children to use the 'Catch It, Bin It, Kill it' strategy when sneezing and coughing.

- Children to avoid touching their mouth, nose and eyes with their hands.
- Children to tell an adult straightaway if they feel unwell.
- Children to not share equipment, cups etc.
- Children to use the toilets that they are allocated.
- No coughing or spitting at or towards any other person.
